

AND WHEREAS the Trustees have accepted the money collected as aforesaid and agreed to act as the Trustees in respect of the aforesaid amount and the amounts collected by or donated to hereafter and the movable and immovable properties (hereinafter called the TRUST PROPERTY) acquired hereafter. And whereas the Trustees have accepted to hold the office of the Trustees as desired by the SETTLER/AUTHOR on the terms and conditions as contained hereinafter:-

NAME:

The name of the Trust shall be NAB (National Association for the Blind) Uttar Pradesh State Branch.

REGISTERED OFFICE:

The registered office and administrative office of the trust shall be at M.M.I.G 275/1 Tikait Rai Colony, Lucknow-226017 until shifted to any other premises or land acquired for the purpose of the trust in any other part of the state of Uttar Pradesh with the decision of the majority of the Trustees.

JURISDICTION:

The Trust shall function within the territory of Uttar Pradesh.

BENEFICIAREIS:

The benefit of the Trust shall be available to visually impaired persons and persons with other disabilities and multi-disabled visually impaired persons.

AFFILIATION:

 NAB, U.P State Branch shall function under the general supervision of NAB, India, and shall abide by the rules and regulations as established by NAB India. Similarly the district



branches of NAB in Uttar Pradesh shall function under the general supervision of NAB, UP.

- NAB U.P State Branch shall also submit its Balance Sheet/Income & Expenditure Statement and Progress Reports annually to NAB India, Mumbai.
- 3. NAB, India shall not be bound and hold no responsibility towards the liabilities of NAB, U.P and similarly NAB, U.P shall not be bound and hold no responsibility towards the liabilities of NAB, India. Similarly, both, NAB, India and NAB, U.P shall hold no responsibility towards the liabilities of the district branches of NAB in Uttar Pradesh.
- NAB India shall only have general supervision over NAB, U.P as well as the district branches of NAB in Uttar Pradesh.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES:

- To look after the welfare of the visually impaired and persons with other disabilities in the State of U.P and to promote their equal participation, socio-economic and general integration in the society.
- To take steps for providing equal opportunities, protection of rights and full social participation of visually impaired persons.
- To provide rehabilitation services to visually impaired and persons with other disabilities at their doorsteps in both rural & urban areas.
- 4. Without prejudice to the generality of the above:



- a. To promote co-operation among associations, institutions, establishments, organizations, societies and individuals working for the welfare of the visually impaired and persons with other disabilities and promote co-operation among them.
- b. To take steps to promote education of the visually impaired by awarding scholarships, engaging resource/ special educators, providing aids and appliances and voluntary readers, establishing schools for the blind / multi-disabled visually impaired persons and promoting integrated education for the visually impaired/ multi-disabled visually impaired persons in any other manner.
- c. To establish or help in establishing institutions, workshops and old age homes for the education, rehabilitation, training, employment, after care and welfare of the visually impaired and other disabled in the state of U.P.
- d. To provide facilities for recreation, sports, entertainment and general welfare of the blind.
- To establish district branches of NAB.
- To provide facilities for communication, coordination of interest and cooperation with similar or allied Trusts, Associations or Societies.
- To arrange and provide facilities for conferences, seminars, workshops, exhibitions, demonstrations, lectures and other functions relating to the cause of the visually impaired and other handicapped persons.



- To establish, equip, promote and maintain suitable research facilities and libraries for the benefit of the visually impaired and other handicapped persons.
- To investigate, collect and circulate information and statistics relating to the visually impaired and other handicapped persons.
- To provide facilities and machinery for the rehabilitation, settlement and re-settlement of the visually impaired persons.
- 10.To provide facilities for establishment of co-operative societies of the visually impaired and fostering a spirit of co-operation among them to create awareness among the general public as to the problems of the visually impaired, their achievements and accomplishments and work being done for the visually impaired.
- 11. To evolve or adopt aids, appliances, accessories, machinery, equipment and other articles used in the education, rehabilitation, employment, economic re-settlement and total development of visually impaired persons, and medical research for the prevention and cure of visual impairment.
- 12. To undertake, conduct, promote and contribute to programs to programs of rural development and or train persons for implementing programs of rural development taking into consideration the needs of the visually impaired persons for promoting their education, training, employment and economic resettlement in rural areas.
- 13. To establish or help in the establishment of services for the production of literature for the blind in all forms including Braille, large print, sound recordings and to undertake or encourage research and manufacture, import and supply of educational,



cultural, recreational and other materials, aids, equipments and appliances for the use of the visually impaired persons.

- 14. To take all necessary steps to train/ promote, organize or maintain agencies for getting the blind employed in Government departments and undertakings, co-operative enclaves, industries, trades, professions, occupation and also to promote, assist blind persons in getting self-employment, and also establish units for persons with disabilities to make home-made/ small scale industry products and to facilitate sale of such products.
- 15. To start or assist educational or vocational institutes for the blind and also workshops, industries and establishments for the training of the blind for the purpose of providing them employment.
- 16. To motivate people to work for the welfare of the visually impaired and persons disabilities.
- 17. To take measures for training of workers, volunteers and administrators engaged in blind welfare work.
- 18. To take necessary steps for the prevention and cure of blindness by establishing or promoting eye hospitals/ clinics, mobile clinics, dispensaries, eye banks and consultancy centers as may be considered expedient and proper.
- 19. To make every effort to provide equal opportunity to the visually impaired persons for there all round development especially in the field of education, training and employment.
- 20. To raise funds for NAB by gifts, donations or otherwise.
- To borrow or raise funds with or without security by way of mortgage, change, hypothecation or pledge of any of the moveable

or immoveable properties belonging to NAB for the purpose of any of the above aims and objectives.

22. To do all such other lawful acts, deeds or things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above aims and objects.

Provided that this Deed of Trust does not enforces the purchase or sale of any moveable or immoveable property.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

a. The names of persons subscribed in this deed shall be the Founder Trustees and shall form the Board of Trustees and shall be Trustees for life. The founder Trustees shall elect from among themselves for a period of 5 years the Chairman and Managing Trustee responsible for the administration of NAB, which for the first term as agreed to by the Trustees on this day, are as follows:-

i. Chairman Mrs. Padma Singh

ii. Managing Secretary Mr. Satya Kumar Singh

b. The board of Trustees may nominate other office bearers, if required for assistance in managing the routine daily affairs of NAB. Such office bearers may consist of one President, not more than three Vice Presidents, one Secretary General, not more than three Secretaries, one Treasurer, and not more than five members of the Executive Council.

c. The board of Trustees may nominate such office bearers from among themselves or amongst persons having immense experience in the field of blind welfare.

d. The Executive Council of NAB shall consist of the Trustees, President, Vice President(s), Secretary General, Secretary(s), Treasurer and the member(s) of the Executive Council.

- e. The term of office, powers, duties and responsibilities of the Executive Council shall be such as determined by the board of Trustees from time to time.
- f. The board of trustees may create one or more additional posts of office bearers in the Executive Council as and when necessary and such posts shall be filled in such a manner as prescribed by the board of trustees.
- g. In the event of any controversy, discrepancy or ambiguity, the decision taken by the board of trustees shall be considered final and binding on the Executive Council.
- h. The board of trustees shall be entitled to frame rules, laws, byelaws or committee or subcommittee for the proper functioning of NAB from time to time as per the requirement.

MEETINGS OF THE BOARD:

- 1. The managing trustee shall convene the meeting of the board of trustees twice in one year. However the managing trustee may convene a special meeting at any time under some special circumstances as and when required. The year will correspond to financial year i.e., commencing from 1st of April and ending on 31st of March coming.
- The aforesaid meeting may be convened by giving 15 days notice with agenda to all the Trustees and the quorum shall be two-third of all the trustees.

VACANCIES:

Vacancy in the Board of trustees shall arise among the Trustees in the following cases when a trustee:



- 1. Resigns or dies.
- Is by a competent court, declared as an insolvent or of unsound mind or sentenced to imprisonment for any offence involving moral turpitude.
- 3. Is expelled by the Board of the Trustees in the manner provided herein.
- Absent himself/herself without showing sufficient cause or explanation for three consecutive meetings of the Board.
- 5. In case the Board of trustees feel that any Trustee is not working in conformity with the aims and objectives of NAB or otherwise feel that his/her working is not in the interest of the Trust, such Trustee may be removed from the Trusteeship by a resolution passed by 2/3rd majority in the meeting of the Board of Trustees, called for the said purpose. This may be the part of the agenda with other items.

APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEES:

- In case of any vacancy arising among the Trustees, new Trustees shall be appointed by the Board of trustees who is of sound mind: is above 18 years of age and who subscribe to the objectives of NAB.
- The Board in its meeting convened for the said purpose shall fill up the vacancies arising in the Board of trustees by a simple majority of existing Trustees attending the meeting by passing a resolution.
- The Board may add one or more Trustees to the existing number of Trustees by a simple majority resolution adopted in a meeting specially convened for the said purpose.



FUNDS AND PROPERTIES:

For achieving any or all of the above Aims & Objectives, NAB may seek funding, support fellowships and other help from different organizations and the following means would be adopted:

- To raise funds through donations, grants, gifts and contributions from persons, nationals and international resources and to obtain and receive loans from associations, firms or institutions, in accordance with the guidelines of the appropriate Government.
- 2. To acquire by purchase/lease/loans/gifts/grants/legacy/bequest/ exchange rights, privileges or otherwise from any person, company, society, government, trust, organization or body whatsoever, moveable or immoveable properties of all descriptions deemed necessary or useful for any purpose of NAB.
- 3. To create, manage and maintain a corpus fund as per the norms determined from time to time by the Board of Trustees.
- 4. To invest funds not immediately required in such manner as may be determined by the Board of Trustees.
- To create, recall or vary all or any of the investments from time to time as per the determination of the Board of Trustees from time to time for the said purpose.
- To give or obtain donations or grants to or from any charitable trust, society, institution, association, and organization etc, performing similar activities.



 To adopt and take such other lawful means as may be incidental and conducive to the accomplishment of all or any of the objectives.

IMMOVABLE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST

No property belonging to NAB shall be sold, exchanged, transferred, converted, mortgaged about or alienated in any manner whatsoever except when such exchange, transfer, conversion or alienation is:

- 1.In the larger interest of NAB in achieving it Aims & Objectives.
- Imperative in the interest of NAB and institution and departments connected therewith.
- 3.Not likely to adversely affect to any extent whatsoever the existence and benefits of NAB, institution or departments connected therewith to fulfill the objectives of NAB, it (NAB) may acquire any moveable and immoveable property through passing. To that effect, by the Board in its meeting by a resolution passed by two third majority of the Trustees present and convened for the purpose.

BANKERS AND OPERATIONS:

The account of the NAB shall be opened in a Scheduled/Nationalized bank operating over India and shall be operated as per the resolution passed by the Board of Trustees in a Board Meeting specially convened by the Managing Secretary for the said purpose from time to time.

INVESTMENTS:

The surplus funds of the trust, if any, shall be kept invested only in such forms & modes as is permitted under the provisions of the Income tax Act,1961 or any other law which may be applicable.



ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

- NAB shall maintain true and correct accounts of its receipts, expenses, funds, and properties. The income and expenditure account and the balance sheet shall be prepared annually at the end of each financial year.
- The accounts shall be audited every year by a chartered accountant appointed by the board of trustees, and shall be eligible for reappointment for the said purpose.
- The financial year of the trust shall commence from such a date as specified in the rules made by the appropriate government from time to time.

SUITS AND LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

- The Managing Trustee or any other trustee as authorized or appointed by the Board may:
- a. Seek legal advice for the trust as required from time to time.
- b. Institute or defend any suits or any other proceedings legal or otherwise instituted by or against the trust before any court, tribunal or authority, judicial or quasi-judicial and shall take all necessary actions for the same.
- c. Enter into any agreement or contract for executing/ registering any document.
- The Board of Trustees may take any other step it may deem think fit to meet any contingency affecting NAB in any legal proceeding or any other matter.



3. The legal jurisdiction in respect to the matter of NAB shall be restricted to Lucknow.

CESSATION OF TRUSTEESHIP:

At the time of cessation of Trusteeship for any reason whatsoever, the Trustees shall not be entitled to any refund of money paid by such Trustee or return of any donation or gifts etc. made to NAB, nor shall have any rights to avail of or continue any facilities accorded by NAB for that reason.

AMENDMENTS:

- 1. If any time it is found that alterations, additions/modifications/ deletions in any of the provisions of this Trust Deed is required for the purpose of effective achievements of the Aims & Objectives of NAB, such amendments/alterations, additions/ modifications are imperative and essential, then the Board of Trustees shall approve of such amendments/ alterations, additions/ modifications, deletions, changes by a resolution passed in its meeting by two third majority approved and verified. Provided that such rules and byelaws shall not be inconsistent with or repugnant to any of the provisions of the scheme of NAB and thereafter such amendments/alterations, additions/ modifications shall be part and parcel of the terms, condition and provisions of this Trust Deed.
- The proposed amendments/ alterations, additions/ modifications, deletions, changes in the Trust Deed shall be communicated to the Trustees along with notice of the meeting of the Board, convened for the said purpose.
- 3. No, amendment/alteration, deletion or addition to the Aims & Objectives or rules and regulations of this Trust Deed shall be carried out except with the approval of two third majority of the



- Such decision or resolution is carried by the votes of at least two third numbers of the Trustees present in the meeting.
- 4. At the time of meeting of the Board of Trustees, there shall exist all the Trustees in office. There shall be no vacancy existing on the Board of Trustees.
- The funds, assets and the income of NAB or any part thereof shall not be distributed amongst the Trustees.
- 6. NAB India, Mumbai shall utilize the property, funds and assets of NAB UP state Branch only for the purpose of welfare of the Blind and other disabled in the state of Uttar Pradesh.

Save as provided here in above, commencement of NAB took place on 27.01.2020 and these provisions shall apply to all the Trustees with effect from the said date.
